Read Genesis 1:1- 2:2

1. When did this take place?
2. How did the work?
3. How much did he create?
4. What phrase reoccurs at the end of each day to show that the Bible is talking about a regular day with about twelve hours of dark and twelve hours of light?
5. How could you respond to someone who said, "This chapter can't be right, since the sun wasn't created until day four and you know all the light we get comes from the sun."
6. What phrase repeated in verses 11, 12, 21, 24, 25, show that plants and animals cannot evolve into a different kind of plant or animal?
7. What blessing did God give to Adam and Eve?
8. What did God give them for food?
9. As God saw all that he had made, what did he conclude at the end of day six?
10. What did God do on the seventh day?

Some people like to try and make the Bible agree with evolution by saying that Genesis 1 & 2 are a myth. But they would have to throw out a lot more of the Bible than those two chapters. Look up the following verses. Write them on the line next to the statement they make that contradicts evolution.
