“The King of the Philistines”

1. What kind of trouble did Abraham's lie get Sarah into?
2. How did the king of the Philistines make it clear that he had not done anything bad to Sarah?

“Isaac and Ishmael”

1. Since the Lord's promises were going to be kept through Isaac, what did the Lord tell Abraham to do with Ishmael, the son he had with Hagar, Sarah's servant?
2. How did God provide for Hagar and Ishmael?

“God Tests Abraham”

1. What did the Lord tell Abraham to do with his son Isaac, whom he loved and through whom the Savior was going to come?
2. What did the Lord provide to take Isaac's place?
3. Who has taken your place as the sacrifice so that he died instead of you?

“Birth of Moses”

1. Abraham's son Isaac became the father of Jacob, whose name God changed to Israel. Jacob was the father of 12 sons. One of his sons, Joseph, became a ruler in Egypt. During a famine, Jacob and his family moved down to Egypt so that Joseph could provide food for them. As the centuries passed, Jacob's family grew into the people of Israel. But after a while Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, forced them to do hard labor. God was going to provide a rescuer for them.
