

Bible Study 7 - How did the Father rescue his ruined creation?

Read Romans 5:6-19

1. In verses 6-8 what three words describe our condition when Christ died for us?
2. What does Christ death for us demonstrate about God? (verse 8)
3. So if God did that for you and me while we were still his enemies, now that you are justified by Jesus blood and reconciled to God y his death, what will God do for you? (verses 9-11).
4. Verse 12 says that sin entered the world through one man. Who was that man? (Genesis 3:17)
5. What did sin bring along with it (verse 12)
6. What happens to everyone that proves that we have all sinned? (verse 12)
7. What command did Adam break? (Genesis 2:16, 17)
8. Verse 13, 14 remind us that God did not give us his written law until many years after Adam (not until Moses at Mt. Sinai). But even though those between Adam and Moses did not break a direct command from God as Adam did, what happened to them anyway that shows that Adam's sinfulness was inherited by his children?
9. Adam sinned. Many, in fact all, have died due to the one trespass (sin) of that one man. Who is the one man who brings us the gift that comes by grace? (verse 15).
10. What does this gift bring even though there have been many trespasses and sins? (verse 16).
11. Death reigned over us because of sin, but when we receive God's gift of righteousness by faith what reigns over us now? (verse 17)
12. Verse 19 sums up what we've been talking about. Let's see how well you can explain it. The verse is broken down into parts. Answer the question for each part.

For just as through the disobedience of the one man ...

Who is this one man?

How did he disobey?

... the many were made sinners ...

How many became sinners?

... so also through the obedience of the one man ...

Who is this one man?

How did he disobey?

... the many will be made righteous.

Whom his Jesus work for?
