

Bible Study 10 - What is Jesus' official position?

Read 1 Samuel 16:1-13

1. Whom had God rejected as king over Israel?
2. What was Samuel to fill his horn with? (In Bible times since they didn't have plastic containers or glass bottles, they would hollow out an animal horn and use it to carry liquids.)
3. Where was Samuel to go?
4. Why was he to go there? (1 Samuel 16:1)
5. How was Samuel to know which son of Jesse (Jesse is the father) to anoint as king?
6. What did Samuel think when he saw Eliab, Jesse's oldest son?
7. Rather than looking at the appearance, where does the Lord look?
8. What were the names of the next two oldest sons of Jesse?
9. Were any of the seven oldest sons chosen by the Lord?
10. Where was the youngest son?
11. What did the Lord tell Samuel to do when he saw Jesse's youngest son?
12. What was the youngest son's name?
13. Like David, Jesus was anointed, but Jesus wasn't anointed with oil. What was Jesus anointed with to show that his work would be much greater than David's? (Acts 10:38)
14. What did David do as King that pictured the work Jesus would do as our King? (compare 2 Samuel 5:17-25 with 2 Corinthians 15:55-57)

Look up the passages and tell whether they describe Jesus' work as Prophet, High Priest, or King (each one is used three times)
