Read Acts 22:1-16

1. The Apostle Paul has preached the Gospel of Jesus in many different cities. Now he is back in Jerusalem. Some of the Jews start a riot against Paul. While the crowds were trying to kill Paul, the Roman commander came to restore order and arrested him. Paul asked if he could speak to the crowd, and the commander gives him permission. Paul begins by explaining how he used to hate the Christians and why that changed. What was Paul thoroughly trained in? (v. 3)
