Bible Study 11 - Lord's Supper: Properly Prepared

Read 1 John 1:5 - 2:2

1. As we prepare for the Lord's Supper we examine our heart's relationship to Jesus. Sections of Scripture like this one can help us do that. Look at verse 5. Which words tell us that God is good, true, holy, pure, sinless?
2. Verse 6 talks about walking in darkness. In your own words describe what it means to walk in darkness.
3. Fellowship means togetherness, sharing, having a strong common bond. Can we have fellowship with God and have a heart that follows sin? (v. 6)
4. Who else do we have fellowship with, if we walk in the light, that is, if we trust God's truth and follow his holy ways? (v. 7)
5. But how can sinners, like you and me, walk in the light? How can we have fellowship with the holy God? What alone can wash us clean? (all three questions have the same answer, v. 7)
6. Some people may imagine that if they try hard enough they can eventually get rid of their sin. But will a true Christian ever claim to be without sin in this life? (v. 8)
7. What does God freely do with all your sins as we confess them to him? (v. 9)
8. Which word in verse 9 means that God keeps his promises of forgiveness?
